RP Witt Construction is starting construction on the All Saints Episcopal Columbarium Expansion this month. The Architect for the project is Robert Wulbern from Jacksonville, FL.

We have also completed the design for an educational project, Christ the King Science Lab, located in Jacksonville, FL. The project is slated to go into permit later this month.

We have begun construction on a NSP Project for ONH Development . The project is located in Jacksonville, FL.
